FERPA GENERAL DISCLOSURE CONSENT FORM Baylor University

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA) was designed to protect the privacy of students' educational records and to establish the rights of students to inspect and review their educational records. In accordance with FERPA, as a general rule the prior written consent of the student must be obtained before the school may disclose the student's educational records to a third party.

ATTENTION BAYLOR OFFICIALS: This consent is not valid unless: (1) the educational records are identified; (2) the person to whom disclosure is to be made is identified; (3) the purpose of the disclosure is listed; and (4) the form is signed and dated by the student. A copy of this consent must be kept with the student's records. In addition, certain Baylor University offices (i.e., Judicial Affairs and the Student Health Center) have different procedures for the release of student records. Students wishing to release records maintained by those offices must contact those offices directly.
